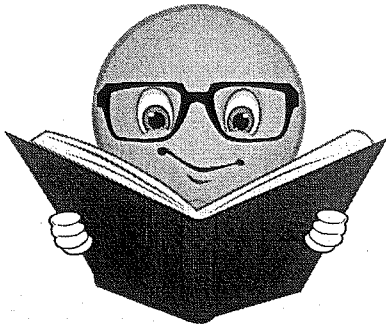
Dear New 4th Grade Parents,
